## Protocols to Keep Children and Volunteers Safe

### GENERAL

- **MASKS** | Masks are currently optional.
- **LIMITED CAPACITY** | We currently have a reduced classroom capacity to help lower numbers.
- **ELECTRONIC CHECK-IN** | Electronic check-in stations have been installed throughout our building to limit face-to-face contact when checking-in children and enrolling new families. These kiosks are sanitized in order to limit exposure.
- **HAND SANITIZING** | Stations will be located throughout our environment.
- **HEALTH AND WELLNESS** | We ask that you stay at home if you or your child are experiencing any signs of sickness that includes, but not limited to fever, cough, running nose, skin rashes, cough, conjunctivitis, loss of taste/smell, etc.

### CLASSROOM

- **HAND WASHING** | Children and volunteers should wash their hands when entering the room and after every diaper change, restroom use, wiping of noses, etc.
- **SANITATION** | Clean toys will be provided for each service hour. Toys and surfaces will be sanitized each hour. Additional measures will be taken to ensure the sanitation of restroom areas between service hours.
- **CURRICULUM** | All curriculum is evaluated to comply with safety and cleanliness guidelines.

### LARGE GROUP SETTING

- **DIGITAL OPTIONS** | Portions of our live large group environment will be shown on a digital platform until further notice. We will also limit the number of live performers.
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING** | Threes and Fours classes are grouped in designated areas of the room to encourage social distancing and for contact tracing when needed.
- **TRAVEL WORSHIP** | Toddlers and Twos are kept within their classrooms throughout the hour and a digital worship experience is being offered.

### FOOD AND DRINK

- **MILK AND FORMULA** | These will be allowed for infants. Please ensure bottles and baby formula are labeled with the child's name.
- **FOOD AND DRINK** | No snacks are being offered to children at this time. Water is available in individual cups upon request. For volunteers, individual bottled water is available. We ask that volunteers remain in designated areas when consuming food and beverages.
